


New model guiding principles

Symbology:


Policy Maker Regulator Operator

New institutional arrangement








Coordinated Regulatory Agencies



Upstream

Common characteristics

- Autonomous agencies depending directly of the Executive Branch (Technical, functional, budgetary and operational autonomy)
- The Executive Branch shall exercise its powers of economic regulation in electricity and hydrocarbons through this agencies in order to promote the efficient development of the energy sector.
- Supported by a governance body consisting of 7 Commissioners: to select each commissioner, the Senate shall choose one of the three candidates nominated by the President of the Republic.
- The Governance body will be governed by a Code of Conduct.
- Sessions, agreements and resolutions shall be held in public unless they reserved information.
- The Agencies can dispose of the revenues derived from the duties of the service they render.
